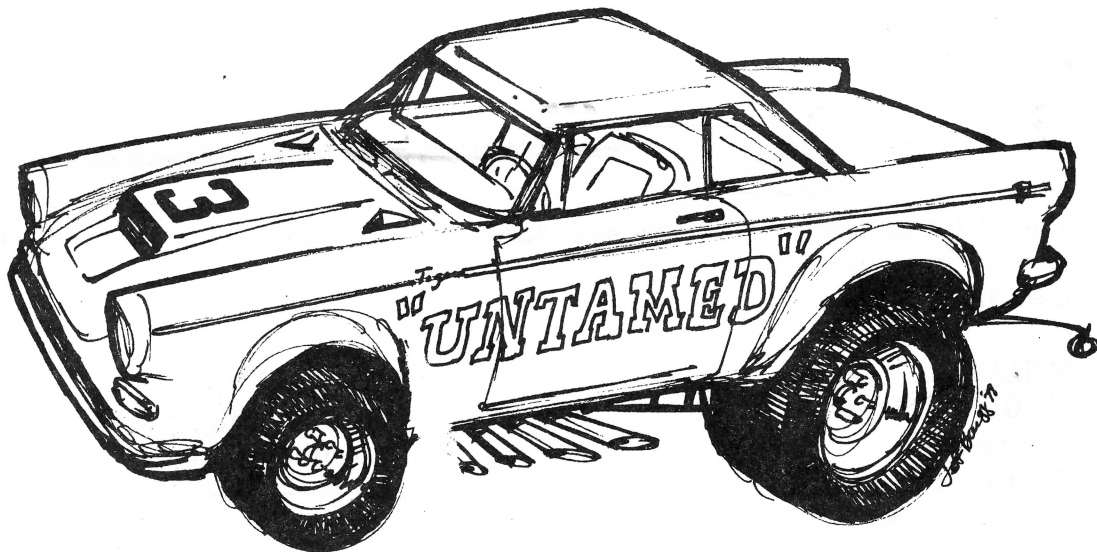

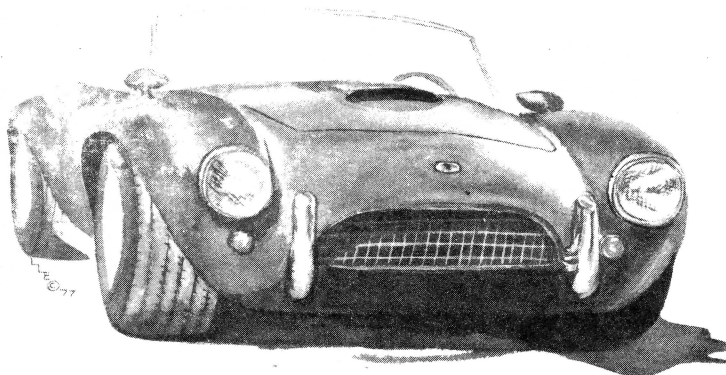

Lee Lockhart submitted the following octane chart which is of interest to us all. This is material which may be next to impossible to obtain in the future. A wise person should store this someplace where it won't be forgotten. Leenotes that Avgas cannot be sold at airports because there is no road tax added. He also notes that the octane stated in your owners manual is the RON (old method)

Here is a table of fuels which will be available in the future, their octane quantities, and the engine compression ratio ranges they will satisfy. Consider this a "catalog" from which you can select several fuels (at several availability levels) for your cars for years into the future.
